Michael Williams is Co-Director of Programming for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Division of Capital Asset Management, better known as DCAM. He has been in his current position since 1994, and has been with DCAM since 1988, when it was called DCPO. DCAM is the public agency responsible for directing and managing the planning, design, and construction of state funded vertical construction, i.e. buildings.

Since passage in 2008 of a \$2.2 billion bond authorization for improvements to the Commonwealth's higher education system, Mike's efforts have been focused primarily on projects for State and Community Colleges and the five campuses of the University of Massachusetts.

DCAM's goal is and has been to attract the best firms to public architecture, and to ensure that all firms be given an equal and fair opportunity for consideration. Over the past 10 years Mike has worked closely with the state's Designer Selection Board, its Executive Director, and Chairmen and board members past and present toward that end.

Mike is a registered architect, a member of the American Institute of Architects and Boston Society of Architects, and has been on the faculty of the Boston Architectural College.
